

**PRIVACY STATEMENT**  
**ARA INNOVATION SPACE (PARTICIPANTS)**

Data protection and privacy are important to us and we are committed to protecting the privacy of all participants. All personal and company data are kept confidential and in compliance with national and European data protection and data security legislation.

**1. Who is responsible for data processing and who can you contact?**

**2. Which data are being processed?**

We process personal data you provide to us when you attend ARA Innovation Space events and/or workshops.

The personal data we collect typically include your name and email address and, in limited cases, your telephone number and address.

**3. What are the purposes and legal basis for processing your data?**

We process your data for managing your participation in ARA Innovation Space events and/or workshops. In this case, the legal basis for processing your data is to perform the contract or take steps prior to entering into a contract iSd Art. 6 paragraph 1 lit b GDPR.

In addition, we will use your personal data to send you newsletters and information about ARA Innovation Space activities, offers, workshops or events, as well as other industry-specific notifications. In this case, the legal basis for processing your data is your consent (Art. 6 paragraph 1 lit. a GDPR). You can revoke your consent at any time by contacting us (see contact details under (1)). This revocation will not affect the legitimacy of data processing before the receipt of the revocation.

**4. Who will have access to your data?**

Those of our employees who need your data to fulfil contractual, legal and supervisory obligations and to pursue legitimate interests will have access to your data. In addition, data processors we work with (specifically IT and back office providers) will have access to your data to the extent required for them to provide their services. In certain cases, we may also pass on your data to our workshop, event or field trip partner(s) for the purpose of managing the respective workshops, events or field trips.

Provided that you have consented to such use, your data (specifically photographs) may be published on our website, Facebook page, Twitter profile, Instagram account and in our documentary (online and at events).

For registration to and issuance of tickets for our events/workshops we use the online ticketing platform Eventbrite Inc 55 5th Street, Floor 7, San Francisco, CA 94103. Eventbrite is certified under the privacy-shield-agreement and thus guarantees compliance with the European data protection law. Eventbrite evaluates and processes information and data for their own purposes and on their own responsibility, such as cookies, AD Tracking and IP-addresses for promotional purpose (also by third parties). We do also not have any information on how long Eventbrite is keeping your data. **5. How long will we keep your data?**

We will process your personal data in electronic form on a needs basis for the duration of your participation in an event or a workshop (from registration to completion) and for as long as we have your consent to do so and after that for the duration of the legal or statutory retention period specified e.g. in the Austrian Commercial Code or the Austrian Federal Fiscal Code; after that, your data will be deleted or stored in depersonalised form only.

**6. What are your data protection rights?**

You have the right to request and receive, free of charge, information on the personal data we hold about you, the origin of the data, the recipient(s) to whom they may be disclosed and the purpose of data processing.

In addition, you have the right to correction of any mistakes in your personal data, the right to erasure of your personal data, the right to restriction of processing of your personal data and the right to data portability. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions about your rights or other issues concerning our use of your personal data (see contact details under (1)).

Finally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which in Austria is the Austrian Data Protection Authority.

**7. Changes to the privacy statement**

We reserve the right to amend our privacy statement to reflect new developments and changing legal requirements. We recommend that you read our privacy statement on a regular basis so you are always up to date about the protection of data we gather.
